The Link Pathway, Te Ara Tuhono, is a newly constructed walk and cycleway connecting Picton with Havelock offering spectacular views of the Queen Charlotte Sound with its intricate bays and coves. The Link Pathway offers an achievable gradient with a wide track that is suitable for most abilities for biking or walking with a moderate fitness level required. It is mostly built to a national cycleway standard of grade 2. The Link Pathway includes several sections of a historic bridle path, built by early settlers and miners in the 1860's through beautiful native New Zealand Beech forest. Search out the WW2 ruins and Punga people along the way.
